EVENT CONFIRMATION – FIELD TRIP CONFIRMATION

STEP 1: PICK UP REGISTRATION

You are scheduled for one of the Pre- or Post-field trips at the 9th Annual Summit. For your convenience the Main Registration Desk will be open from 10am – 1pm Monday, February 17 and 4pm – 8pm, Tuesday, February 18 so that you can pick up your registration materials, including your ticket for the field trip. The NANPA Registration Desk will be located in the upper level foyer of the West Complex within the Albuquerque Convention Center.

STEP 2: MEET WITH INSTRUCTORS

You will also need to attend a mandatory meeting with your field trip leaders prior to leaving for the trip to get instructions for your field trip. The time of the meeting will be sent to you at a later date.

STEP 3: BOARDING INFORMATION

Each trip will need to meet as a group and check-in with the instructors. After roll call the group will get instructions for loading equipment and boarding the bus. The meet and board location will be sent to you at a later date.

STEP 4: LATER COMMUNICATION

Be aware that you will receive further information about your field trip participation closer to the Summit. Future information will be sent to you by email (hard copy for those individuals we do not have emails for).

EQUIPMENT TO BRING:

Bosque del Apache National Wildlife Refuge

Participants should bring one or two camera bodies, an assortment of fixed focal length or zoom lenses including an intermediate or preferably long telephoto lens, a sturdy tripod, a tripod head for easier panning, and of course plenty of film! A motor drive is helpful but not absolutely necessary. It may be very cold, so layers of warm clothing including hats and gloves are advised.

Participants should bring one or two camera bodies, an assortment of fixed focal length or zoom lenses including wide angle, a sturdy tripod (a must!), and of course plenty of film! It may be chilly, so layers of warm clothing including hats and gloves are advised.
