In 1996, NANPA formed the NANPA Infinity Foundation (now called the NANPA Foundation), a non-profit organization designed specifically to foster the awareness of and appreciation for nature through photography. The Foundation is currently funding two major programs. One provides scholarships for high school aged youths to attend the Summit and participate in field experiences with top professionals. The second is constructing and maintaining photo blinds on Fish and Wildlife Refuges throughout the United States.
