- NANPA shall have the right to store a digital copy of the photographs(s) for these purposes.

- A copyright/credit line supplied by the photographer will accompany every usage.
- Photographers will be notified by email prior to publication about when and how their image will be used. NANPA will send two copies of each printed usage, in a timely manner (oversized pieces, i.e. billboards, large posters etc will be the exception to this rule.)
- NANPA reserves the right to crop and reorient any photograph for design or editorial purposes. However, every effort will be made to maintain the original integrity and intent of the image.

WARRANTY:

By supplying this photograph(s) to NANPA for use, the photographer or his assigns warrants that:

1. He/she has the right to enter into this agreement.
2. The photograph(s) does not infringe on any common law or statutory or proprietary right of another, or invade the privacy of any person.
