



How to Write and Submit a Blog Post

What is a blog post?

The NANPA News Blog (<http://www.nanpa.org/news/>) is a place where members can share ideas, photography tips, and information about their projects. The blog features short articles written by different authors.

Writing a blog post is just like writing a short article or story on a specific topic. NANPA is now accepting blog post submissions from all NANPA members and we invite you to send us your article or idea (see instructions below).

Topics and Examples

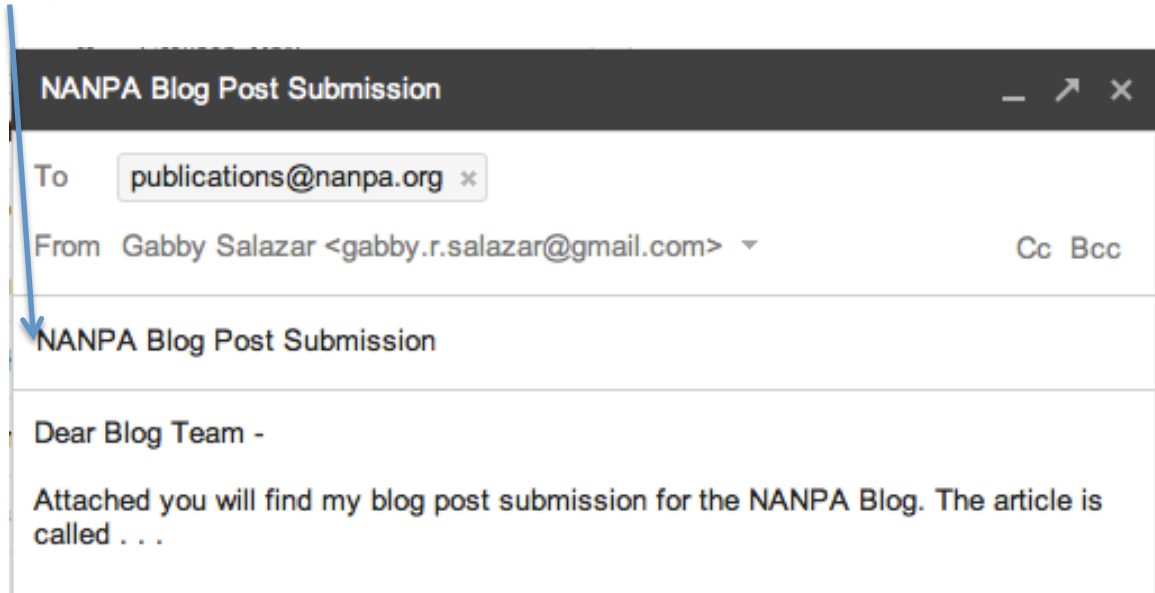
The NANPA Blog Team is looking for submissions that have the following themes:

- Nature photography tips and techniques
- Photography destinations (popular and unknown)
- Travel tips for photographers
- Photo business tips
- Inspirational articles
- Member projects (highlight your project)
- Other Topics (send in an idea)



How to Submit Your Blog Post:

1. Submit your blog post by email to publications@nanpa.org
2. **Type** NANPA Blog Submission in the Email Subject Line



3. **Type** your blog post in a word document and attach it to your email.
4. Also attach your photos to the email. These can be attached individually or in a ZIP File.

Do's:

- **Word Count:** NANPA Blog Posts are between 500 and 800 words in length.



- **Photo Specifications:** Send up to six images from which our team will select two or three. Images should be JPEGs saved at the highest quality settings. They should be at least 7 inches on the longest side at 200 dpi. Maximum file size per image should be 3MB.
- **Biography and Links:** At the bottom of your blog article, please include a short biography written in the third person (100 words or less) along with any links you would like us to include (example: your photo website).
- Separate the post into paragraphs with strong topic sentences.
- Reread to double-check your grammar.
- Sum up your main points in a concluding paragraph.
